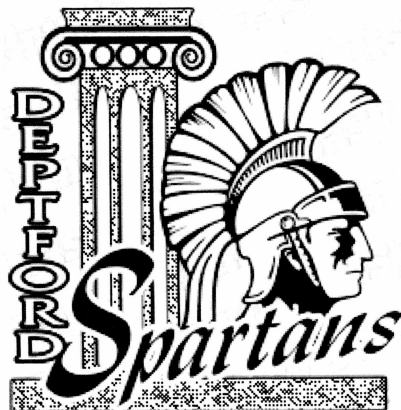

I Want My Deptford Day!

The 37th annual Deptford Day kicks off on May 15th with a theme of "I Want My Deptford Day!" The Al Cunard Memorial Deptford Day Parade starts at 10am running from the Deptford Municipal Building to Fasola Park. The parade features over 70 entries including 2 string bands, local youth sports clubs, pageant winners, area business mascots, Little Mr. & Miss Deptford Day 2009, local fire battalions, and much more. The parade starts on Cooper Street in front of the Deptford Municipal Building, continues on to Good Intent Road, making a right on to Hampshire Drive in to Bexhill Farms and finishes at the rear entrance of Fasola Park.

At a new time this year, Opening Ceremonies kicks the festivities off on the lower level stage at 11:45am. The entire day is filled with musical entertainment for everyone, rides for the young and old alike. Crafters Lane, on the upper level, featuring vendors selling unique goods. On the lower level, there are local businesses and organizations manning booths, and food vendors galore. Come to the park and ride a pony or challenge yourself on the rock climbing wall. There is a jousting game as well, to pit yourself against your friends. Ride down the 3 story tall slide or catch a local band, karate club or magician on stage during the afternoon.

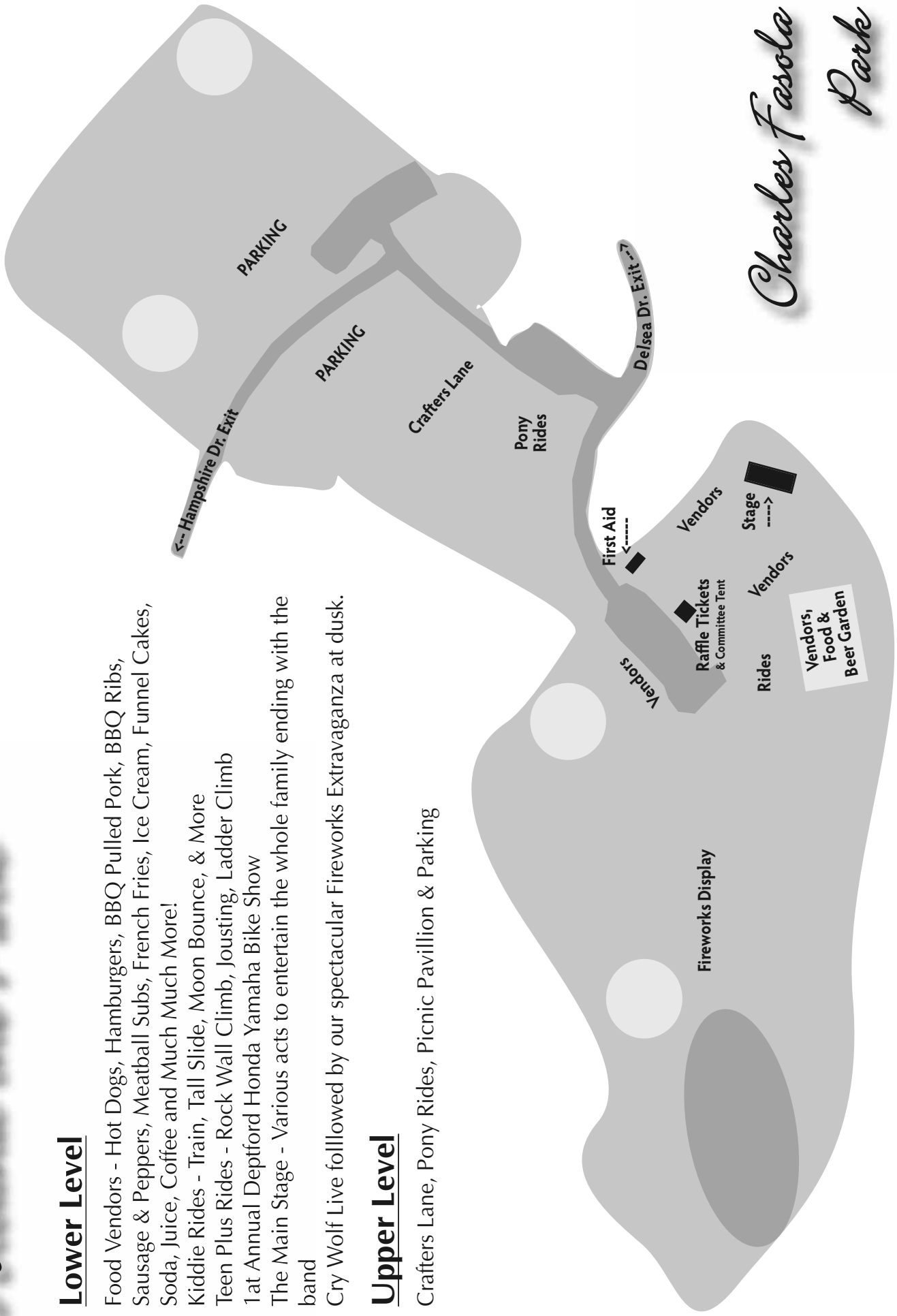

In 1990 Mike & Joe decided to put a band together. Bringing together Joe's natural ability to play music the way it should be played....straight from the heart and Mike's talent and over 30 years of road and recording experience giving Cry Wolf it's authentic Rock feel. Shortly after they started Cry Wolf they started looking for another guitar player and found Eric. His distinctive guitar playing and natural feel add an important element to the Cry Wolf sound. They then looked for a bass player and Joe knew no one could fill the slot better than Ed. He has built a solid rhythm foundation of sound by providing the raw energy that fuels the Cry Wolf rhythm section. In the fall of 2003 the band was introduced to Sean,

at a performance one night by a mutual friend. After singing a couple of songs on stage with the band, he knew they would make a good fit. Soon thereafter, Sean joined the band. Now as they are five musicians, known as Cry Wolf Live. They love playing rock clubs though out South Jersey and the Philly area, playing private parties, outdoor concerts, events for some of the local Harley Davidson dealerships, and biker rallies. 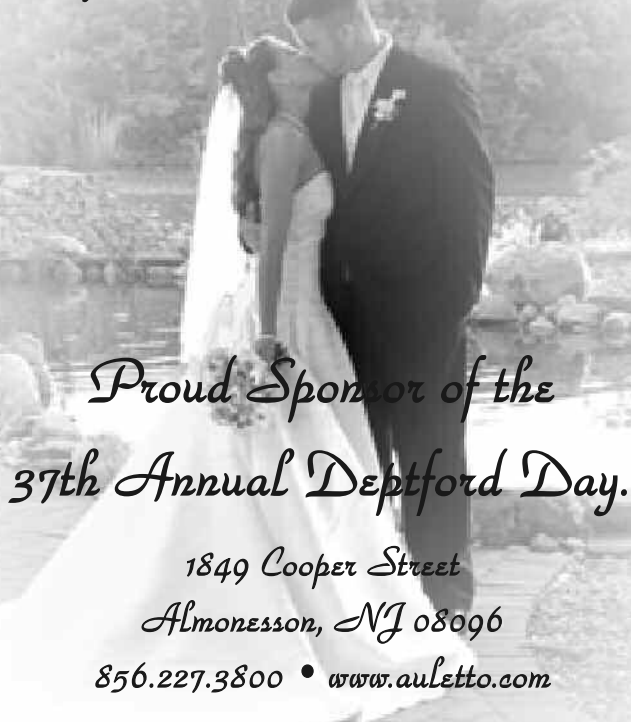
